SECURITY AND SAFETY AT WEST HOUSTON AIRPORT

West Houston Airport would like to remind all our patrons, customers, and visitors about potential security issues or risks in and around the premises. Be proactive and keep a watch for every

ones safety and security. Listed below are a few reminders to be aware of while you are at the airport or securing your aircraft.

1) Keep aircraft locked and secured at all times (make sure the brakes are off). You wouldn't park your car and leave it unlocked in a parking garage or apartment complex. It's the same here. 2) Don't leave headsets or other valuable items, inside of the aircraft, in plain view. It is recommended that you take them with you. 3) When entering the gated access area, make sure the gates close completely before moving ahead, do not allow others to follow you in the gates. 4) Do not give out your special gate code to friend,



customers or for deliveries. If needed, we have a special weekly visitor gate code. We will be happy to give you that code for temporary use, contact our Customer Service Representatives at the front desk for that number. 5) Make sure you inform your visitor(s) See Safety Continued page 3

remember when giving them the address (18000 Groschke Rd) give them your Hangar number and indicate that it is in Harris County not the City of Houston.

- 7) Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
- 8) If you have someone coming out to retrieve aircraft, look at aircraft, or have a buddy fly your plane, you must call ahead or email our Customer Service Representative to give that person approval to gain access to your aircraft.
- 9) Be courteous when tug crews are moving aircraft along taxiways. Do not speed or attempt to swerve around as they have the right of way. Wait for them to acknowledge you and signal the ok to go around. 10) Speed limit is 20MPH on all taxiways. 11) Ongoing construction is on the Airport, be courteous to all. 12) Crime is out there everywhere, so let's do everything we can to prevent it. Thank you for your due diligence.




