Density Altitude

When the air temperature increases, the air molecules move farther apart causing the air to become less dense. This density is the same as a higher altitude on a standard temperature day, thus, a higher density altitude.

At higher density altitudes, the engine cannot produce as much power as normal and the wings cannot generate as much lift.

When planning your summer trips to the high country, be sure to choose a route that will permit you to fly at altitudes within your airplane's capability. Sometimes, short loading fuel may be necessary. Just make shorter legs. It is not always true that "you never have too much

If you have been having difficulty finding an FAA Designated Flight Examiner with an open slot in their flight test schedules, you are not alone. There has been a shortage of Examiners in the Houston District for more than a year and it has gotten worse lately with three or more dropping out and no new ones being appointed. There seems to be no indication of any relief anytime soon.

At the present time the only relief may be to reach out to other Districts. The Houston FSDO (Flight Standards District Office) covers

the area from the Gulf of Mexico, the Texas-Louisiana State line as far north as Nacogdoches and the west side beyond Eagle Lake and Palacios.

fuel unless you are on fire." Choose fuel stops at airports with elevations low enough for you to tak off without waiting for winter.

One fellow that I knew purchased an airplane in August. His first fuel stop was at a high elevation airport. After three unsuccessful takeoff run attempts, he had to give up. At least he had the good sense to abort (reject) the takeoffs in time to stop on the runway. He retrieved his airplane in cooler weather near Christmas.
