














End of Year Announcements and News Briefs

Do not call a 10 mile final and expect to cut others off. This will be a violation of the FAA's and the Airport's Rules and Regulations. Pilots flying the RNAV approaches and/or being handed off from ATC in VFR conditions: Cleared for the approach is <u>not</u> a clearance to land


