In Memory of James Robert Sloane

James "Jim" Sloane worked as a flight instructor for us in the early 1970's. He sold aircraft and was a charter pilot during his tenure. Answer to the November "Question of

The Month": A glass jar or bottle full of liquid is harder to break than an empty one. You are flying cross country in moderate turbulence. An important aspect of flying in turbulence that relates to your plane and your safe flight relates to the full and empty jar as indicated above. What should you consider based on the above hint?

Answer: The maneuvering (Va) speed is the important factor here. When anticipating or actually flying through turbulence the pilot flying should know the maneuvering speed for the particular weight of the aircraft. Remember that the maneuvering speed goes down as weight goes down due to the airframe being lighter and less agile than with the extra fuel in the wings, which provides extra strength.



Question for December:

What aircraft was manufactured with a pneumatic flap system and has retractable landing gear but no gear switch? This particular aircraft was designed to operate the controls without cables and it has a tubular construction.


