### What factors drive up rates?

Taxes, utilities, insurance, labor, capital costs, and interest are all factors that drive up rates.

Taxes are not stagnant. Both the appraised value and rates go up every year. If one stays the same, the other increases.

If an entity makes improvements, it is penalized by taxing authorities that increase the value of the property. That is a regressive tax and actually discourages keeping properties in good condition.

Utilities go up as the rate and usage goes up. Even when the company owns its own utility, costs for taxes, insurance, electricity, chemicals, repairs including broken pipes, and labor rises.

Insurance is another issue. When the cost of repairs or replacements increases, so does the cost of insurance. Deductibles increase and coverages decrease. When damage or other losses occur, the rates go up the next year to offset those losses, even if it's not your fault.

Labor is continuing to go up as the cost of living increases. This is not the fault of the laborer. Companies must stay ahead of this while watching what the competition is doing in a very tight labor market.

Capital costs including replacement costs such as purchasing steel products, water wells, fuel tanks, fuel trucks, vehicles and more. Ten years ago I paid \$30k for a new Lektro aircraft tug. Today the scaled down version is \$50k. A new John Deere finishing mower is \$27k compared to the previous one I purchased for \$14k. The new ice maker in our hospitality area cost \$4,500! The cost of goods is unbelievable.

An entity may not pay any interest, but others that are vendors do. With the higher interest rates comes a higher cost and increased prices on goods and services.

Flying is not cheap and it's not going to get less expensive. Companies including West Houston must keep up with these ever-increasing prices or reduce services. Since Covid, there is very little customer service anymore. Maybe that will change but that's a few years off, in the meantime we are going to continue working to increase our customer base.

Please keep these points in mind as the airport adjusts to these ever-increasing costs.






