COMMON TRAFFIC ADVISORY FREQUENCY (CTAF) The COMMON TRAFFIC ADVI-SORY and the UNICOM FRE-**OUENCY** for Houston West Airport is 123.05

MHz. This frequency is used by other airports within 150 miles, plus many helicopters in the Gulf of Mexico.

Airports have UNICOM advisory services as a courtesy to pilots for utility use and to enhance safety in their area. Unicom Operators do not function as tower controllers. Usually, they are not in a location on the airport where they can view the air traffic. All sorts of people answer the Unicom. They should not be relied upon to render expert information or advice about air traffic movements or positions. It would serve you better to keep your eyeballs outside the cockpit looking for other traffic and monitor calls made by other pilots and try to visually locate them. Make yourself visible by using your rotating or flashing beacon, strobe lights and taxi or landing light.

Please avoid abusive use of radio calls that block the calls of other pilots and render them õunreadable.ö The more common calls that fall into this category because of pilotøs thoughtless action are:

1. õRADIO CHECKö calls when there is no cause to suspect a radio malfunction unless departing on an instrument flight. 2. õREQUEST AIRPORT ADVISORYö

when existing wind and traffic conditions make it obvious which runway is in use. 3. Making calls before checking and adjusting volume controls to make it possible to hear a reply.

4. The pilotøs failure to organize his/her thoughts before engaging his/her finger or thumb with the microphone switch.

5. Addressing calls to õWEST HOUS-TON UNICOMö when the actual intent is to obtain the attention of oWEST HOUS-TON TRAFFICö.

6. Making calls from 10 or more miles out õANY TRAFFIC IN THE PATTERN, PLEASE ADVISEö or õPLEASE RE-PORTö. Imagine 6 or 7 pilots trying to answer such a call. Fortunately, most pilots dongt answer this type of call but do especially watch-out for someone like this.

When departing for a flight, most of your questions about radio malfunctions, runway-in-use and winds can be handled at the airport counter. When approaching a non-towered airport these questions can be solved simply by monitoring the COM-MON TRAFFIC ADVISORY FRE-OUENCY (CTAF) from 10 miles out long enough to orient yourself to local conditions. After making a reasonable effort and you still cannot determine for yourself which runway to use because of changing or questionable weather, then call for õAIRPORT ADVISORYö.

Many airports have pilot-controlled runway lighting. West Houston Airport has pilot-controlled runway and Runway-End Identification lights (REIL) on the Unicom frequency. Runway lights are on Level 3 (Low) until changed by a pilot. landing or takeoff.

It is the pilotøs responsibility (not the Unicom Operator_(%) to turn-up the runway lights to Medium (5 mic clicks or 7 clicks for high) intensity. Great care should be taken to avoid blinding someone making a landing or takeoff.
