ATTENTION PILOTS

Houston Executive Airport (TME) is scheduled to have a Control Tower, operating daily from 0600 to 2200 local time effective October 1, 2014. It will not have a class D airspace but the operating and com-


munication requirements are essentially the same when less than 2,000 ft MSL and within a four nautical mile radius from the airport center.

The Tower frequency will be 126.975 MHz. Ground Control 132.075 MHz and Clearance delivery will be on ground control. When the tower is closed Clearance Delivery will be from Houston TRACON, Telephone 281-433-5844.

Sport Flyers Airport has exempted Air Space as depicted below.

This new information will not appear on Sectional Charts or Class B Charts before March 2015. Consult NOTAMS until then.

It is recommended that departing and arriving traffic for West Houston Airport plan to avoid TME by at least 4 Nautical miles or cross over Houston Executive airport at or above 2000 MSL.


