#### Carbon Monoxide By, C.G. "Hank" Henry

The warm weather days are almost gone for this year. Cabin fresh air vents are going to be closed and cabin heat turned on more often. Now is a good time to obtain or check the carbon monoxide detectors



(available at West Houston Airport and most FBO's).

It only takes a small hairline crack along a weld or anywhere on the barrel of the exhaust mufflers or the combustion chamber of your expensive combustion heater to admit a big snoot full of carbon monoxide (CO) into your breathing air. The CO occupies space in the blood cells that carry oxygen causing you to suffer hypoxia. Remember it is colorless, odorless and tasteless.

How would you first know that you are exposed to CO? Since your brain and eyes require more oxygen, per ounce of tissue, than anything else in your body, you can expect to notice difficulty in focusing your vision and maybe feel a little light headed and head achy.

As CO accumulation progresses, you should notice a blue coloration of your finger nails and passenger's lips, tunnel vision, judgment, (page 2 Henry)



memory, a flushed feeling, euphoria or belligerence, muscle weakness, drowsiness, and finally unconsciousness.

These symptoms will not necessarily occur in any particular order. Much depends on your health and if you are fatigued, under stress or smoke. Smoking produces quite a bit of CO. Some authorities indicate that a one-pack-a-day smoker is living at the 8,000 foot level even when walking the beach at sea level.

If you suspect the presence of CO, turn "off" the cabin heat and open plenty of fresh air - right in your face. Take the action as soon as possible, before you lose the mental ability to do so.


