MEDICAL REFORM BECOMES LAW

PRESIDENT SIGNS FAA EXTENSION

President Barack Obama on July 15 signed third class medical reforms into law as part of an FAA authorization extension passed by the House and Senate days earlier. With the president's signature, which came just hours before the FAA's authorization was set to expire at midnight, medical reforms became law and the clock started ticking on an FAA mandate to translate that law into regulations.

Under the reforms, pilots who have held a valid medical certificate any time in the decade prior to July 15, 2016, Medical Continued on page 3

AOPA's At a Glance Medical reform highlights

Aircraft specifications: Up to six seats, up to 6,000 pounds (no limitations on horsepower, number of engines, or gear type)

Flight rules: Day and night VFR and IFR

Passengers: Up to five passengers

Aeromedical training: Pilots must take a free online course

every two years

Altitude restrictions: Up to 18,000 feet msl

Airspeed limitations: 250 knots indicated airspeed

Pilot limitations: Cannot operate for compensation or hire

FAA RESTORES BIRTHDAY SOLOS

The FAA announced July 26 that, beginning immediately, a student pilot to solo on their fourteenth or sixteenth birthday, depending on the type of aircraft they are operating, can submit a paper application up to 90 days before his or her eligible birthday, allowing time for the application to be processed and the student to be vetted by the TSA before his or her birthday. Once approved, the FAA will provide the student with a temporary authorization to exercise the privileges of a student pilot certificate through the Airmen Online Services section of its website. The temporary authorization will be available on the student's birthday and remain valid for 60 days. The FAA will mail a permanent certificate to the student pilot within that 60-day window. 

may not need to take another FAA medical exam. The 10-year lookback period applies to both regular and special issuance medicals. Pilots whose most recent medical certificate was revoked, suspended, withdrawn, or denied will need to obtain a new medical certificate before they can operate under the reforms. Pilots who have never held an FAA medical certificate, including student pilots, will need to go through the pro-

cess one time only.

After meeting the initial requirements to fly

under the reforms,

pilots will need to visit a statelicensed physician at least once every four years and take a free online course on aeromedical factors every two years. For more Information visit AOPA.com Articles by Elizabeth A Tennyson
