In due respect, West Houston Airport has been "lucky as heck" during and following the heavy thunderstorms of last week. Hooks Airport and Houston Executive Airport both had flood water up around their buildings or taxiways. IWS was open and able to fuel incoming aircraft and have options for getting where you need to go with multiple entry accesses.

Texas Highway 6 and Eldridge are still flooded and are

not expected to recede in 4-6 weeks. All through traffic must share the spaces on neighboring thoroughfares.

If you can avoid it, I recommend traveling off peak rush hours. Although getting from here to there is passable, it may take a little more time than usual. Call in advance or look at your local traffic for extended travel time.

#### The Proposal

The FAA is proposing an amendment to Title 14, Code of Federal Regulations (14 CFR) Part 71 by establishing Class D airspace, and Class E surface area airspace extending upward from the surface to and including 2,500 feet MSL within a 4-mile radius of TME (Houston Executive Airport), excluding that airspace west and northwest, to accommodate the establishment of an airport traffic control tower. Class E airspace extending upward from 700 feet above the surface would be established within a 6.6-mile radius of Houston Executive Airport to accommodate new standard instrument approach procedures for the safety and management of IFR operations at the airport.


#### The Facts

The proposed Class D height to 2500 MSL is excessive, leaving only 500 feet between it's top and the floor of Class B, which bases at 3,000 MSL. The very busy DWH (David Wayne Hooks Airport) has been getting along fine for more than 35 years with the top of their Class D at 2000 MSL. TME has such a small amount of traffic watching an aircraft move is rare.

This rule, if enacted, eliminates the free use of the heavily traveled VFR Corridor along interstate 10 from San Antonio, TX to Lake Charles, LA which has existed for some thirty years. It directly effects VFR traffic on Victor airways and cuts into flight training area, used by flight schools at West Houston Airport, Weiser Airport and Hooks Airport as well as cramping the daylights out of Sport Flyers and Skydive Houston Airports and the everyday pilot trying to get from here to there.

#### The Comment

Propose to limit the top of this Class D to 2000 MSL, if a need develops in future years, increase the height of its top then, not now. This allows VFR pilots to continue to fly at 2,500 MSL along I-10; keep it at 2000 ft. If airspace is raised to 2,500 MLS this allows only 500 feet between Class B and Class D airspace. Limiting the airspace to 2,000ft provides a safer airspace for the vast majority VFR General Aviation pilots that fly in the area.
