

## **ON OCTOBER 1st ONLY 456 Days UNTIL ADSB REQUIRED** HOLY COW that's not far away From General Avionics, Inc

FAA numbers (GA) 52,000 installed, 46,000 working CORRECTLY, 200,000 is the conservative number of aircraft still needing ADSB before January 1, 2020 or stay out of controlled airspace.

If you receive a notice (phone, email, letter) that your equipment is not working, you have 45 days to comply before the FAA FLIPS A SWITCH and no more traffic TIS-B for you. FIS-B Weather is still good. Fix your gear or BAM, no TIS-B traffic. That information is straight from the ADSB FAA TEAM! Here is the link to testing your ADSB unit performance.

It does not matter by whom, or when it was



installed... NO TRAFFIC after that 45 day notice. The FAA will then disable your traffic request that is sent to your receiver. (N# generated) Weather will not be effected.

Get your report, if you took advantage of FAA Rebate you are good to go. Many shops, including mine, have multiple options. How long are you going to wait?

A few options: If you have a working mode aircraft transponder Garmin GDL82 is a very popular unit (Good to 18,000 ft), Free Flight has ADSB out options as well.

There are no Certified Aircraft portable OUT options...

Yes, your Stratus or Garmin GDL39/52 or home made unit will Blue tooth without an ADSB in unit.

General Avionics is currently offering a fresh Biannual IFR Certification for FREE if your ADSB gets equip by us!

The FAA has made getting medical certification easier, don't let ADSB shut you down. I still remember the outcry over Mode C mandated in the late 1980's. It was a pill to swallow, but let's face it, it works. Many enroute controllers are now advis-
